- 1. Regarding members from alumni, the departments the departments were of the opinion that although alumni were willing to be part of IQAC their participation in meetings was difficult as they were not able to come in person due to their workand personal commitments. Hence it was agreed that alumni could be intimated through mail and allowed to contribute suggestions through mail.
- 4. The members were requested to prepare details for AQAR report as per the same format for the academic year17-18.
- 5. The AQAR report 17-18 was being prepared and will be sent to NAACIQAC at the ealiest.
- 6. The quality enhancement activities carried out for the academic year17-18 were presented by the members as follows:
- The readiness of Students' Information System for the portal being created by the IT department was reported and in the coming academic year all entries with respect to attendance and marks could be uploaded in the portal and every faculty/ student would be able to view the details in various modes such as daily postings, reports class wise, student wise etc. This was appreciated by the members and it was suggested that after ensuring the success of the SIS, the log books and the Academic Performance record maintained by the teachers and for the students could be made defunct in duecourse thus savingpaper. SIS could include a provision for storing other details of each student such as project work, other academic achievements and extra and co-curricular activities.
- ii) Use of more number of NPTEL videos for teaching leaning process and also for self-study by students and teachers.
- iii) The initiation and successful conduct of meetings of Toast Masters; Club for augmenting English language skills
- iv) Preparation of question banks for all courses to improve the quality of the question papers.
- v) Industry supported hands –on training for both faculty and students
- vi) Faculty visit to industries and institutions for exploring the possibilities of placement, training and internships for students
- vii) MoUs signed with Industries /companies related to projects and solutions
- viii) Use of online courses designed by Industries for students
- ix) Conduct of Interdisciplinary workshop by CSE, IT, ECE and EEE departments and intra disciplinary program by CSE for the students
- x) The procedural change in the conduct of retest for Formative Assessment to ensure effective learning process
- 7. Under Quality enhancement activities for the current year , the following were discussed: as follow up of the previous meeting held on 2.5.18
 - a) Focus to be given ontraining the students progressing towards higher studies in appearing for and scoring in qualifying examinations like GATE

- b) To enhance opportunities for employment in core companies/ industries and PSUsfor EEE, Mechanical and Civil engineering students
- c) Projects in Industries monitored by the industry expert and evaluated by the expert with a faculty member as an Internal Guide
- d) Video lectures of new courses offered by IITs and UGC to be used in teaching- learning process this year also
- e) Video recording of class lectures to be used by slow learners as and when required
- f) A Student Activity Center (as planned in the previous meeting) for promoting literary, technical and fine arts activities
- 8. Invited lectures, Seminars would be planned on Quality enhancement in the institution in this academic year. Some departments have already started Guestlectures for students
- 9. Under Automation and paperless communication, the development of SIS was recognized as a ecofriendly move and it was also agreed upon by all the members that more automation procedures could be developed
