



Method Adopted: The course employed a combination of lectures, and interactive discussions.

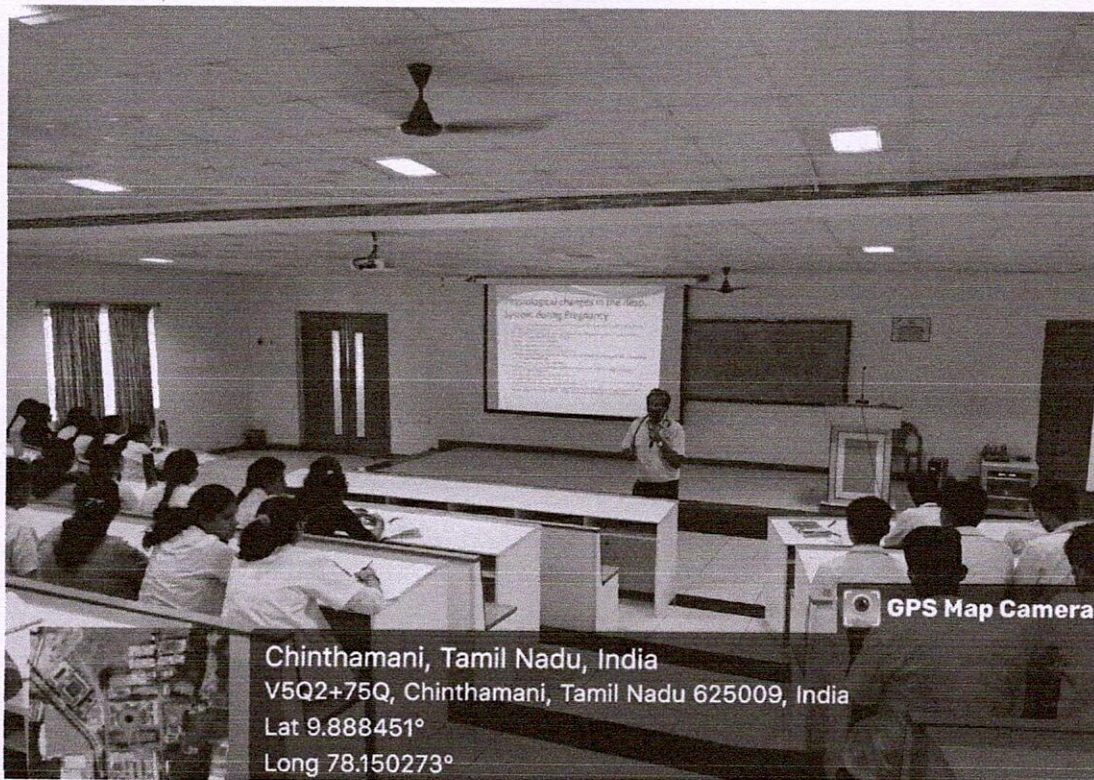

Outcome Analysis: The course received positive feedback from participants, indicating an improved understanding of chronic disease management in an effective way.


