

Day 1:


Students were seated into 7 groups by assigning a number between 1-7 and asked to be seated according to that number in order to ensure interaction across batches and a good mixing of people.

5. Summary of Value-Added Education Course on Research

The course was held in the lecture hall in the college on 3.5.24, over the course of 1 hour from 11 am to 12pm. The course was for the First year MBBS students of VMCH 2023 batch, aimed at introducing them to research and teaching them how to write the protocol. 145 students were present on the day and they attended the course.

An introduction regarding the basics of research and how to come up with original ideas as well as the beneficial effects of research was given by Dr. Amritha, CRRI.



The next part of the session involved an interactive game dubbed as "Battle of Rows and Columns". Each column formed a team (3 teams) that were asked to go against each other and each row (9 rows) were given a research topic. The students of 1 row formed subgroups that would battle against each other to represent each column team. Each team was required to come up with a short "pitch" as to the benefits and impact of their topic if it was to be approved as well as potentials issues that the project could cause. Then teams were asked to speak either for or against the topics given on spot. The aim of the activity was to give students an idea on analysis the good and bad implications of topics and learning how to highlight the good impact
