

The Department of Microbiology at Velammal Medical College Hospital & Research Institute organized a seminar on "Biomedical Waste Management" on 28th November 2023 in demonstration hall. The seminar aimed to create awareness about the proper management and disposal of biomedical waste, ensuring the safety to laboratory technicians and nursing staff working in the central laboratory of Velammal Medical College Hospital.

The program commenced with an inauguration ceremony at 9.00 am, followed by a pre-test from 9.15 to 9.30 am. The pre-test was designed to assess the participants' existing knowledge and understanding of biomedical waste management, providing a baseline for evaluating the effectiveness of the seminar.

At 9.30 am, Dr. Ramesh MD, Professor of Microbiology, delivered the introduction to the seminar. Dr. Ramesh provided an overview of the significance of proper biomedical waste management in healthcare settings and its implications for public health and safety.

At 9.45 am, Dr. Vithiya MD, Assistant Professor of Microbiology, Professor of Microbiology, presented on biomedical waste segregation and the different types of biomedical waste. This session emphasized the importance of proper segregation of biomedical waste to ensure safe disposal and minimize environmental and health hazards.

At 11.00 am, Dr. Ramesh MD, Professor of Microbiology, conducted a session on the segregation of biomedical waste, particularly in critical areas like operating theaters (OTs). This session addressed the specific challenges faced in OTs and provided insights into best practices for proper segregation and disposal.

Following a lunch break at 12.30 pm, the seminar resumed with a session on spill management by Dr. Vithiya MD. This session covered the protocols and measures to be taken in the event of a biomedical waste spill, emphasizing the importance of prompt and effective response to prevent potential hazards.

A post-test was conducted at 2.30 pm to assess the participants' understanding and retention of the topics covered during the seminar. At 2.45 pm, students were

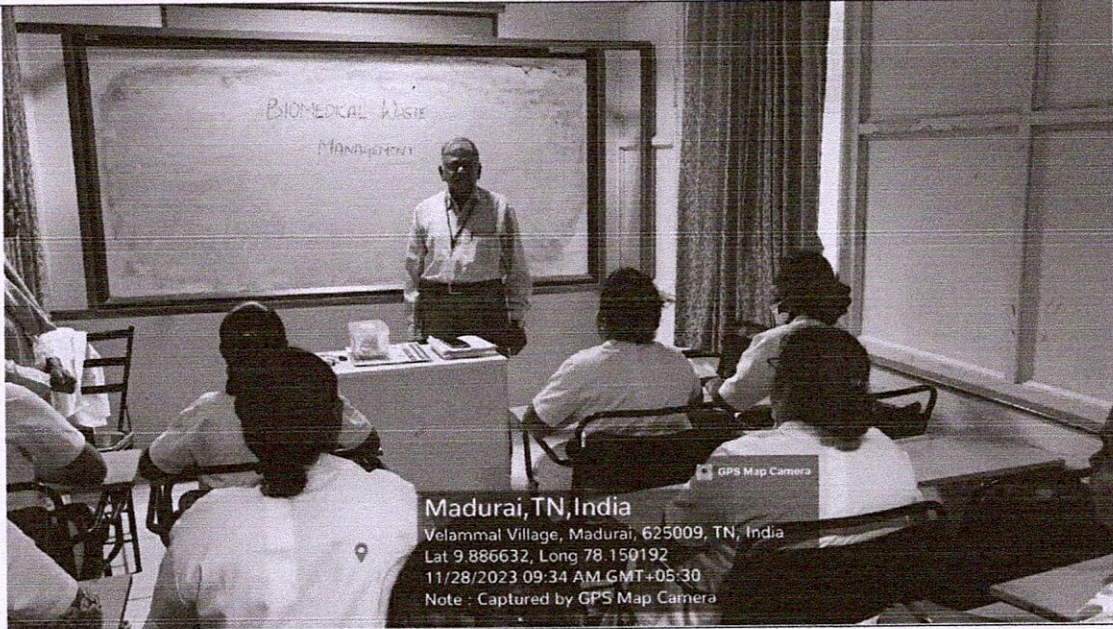



Biomedical waste segregation & types – Dr Vithiya

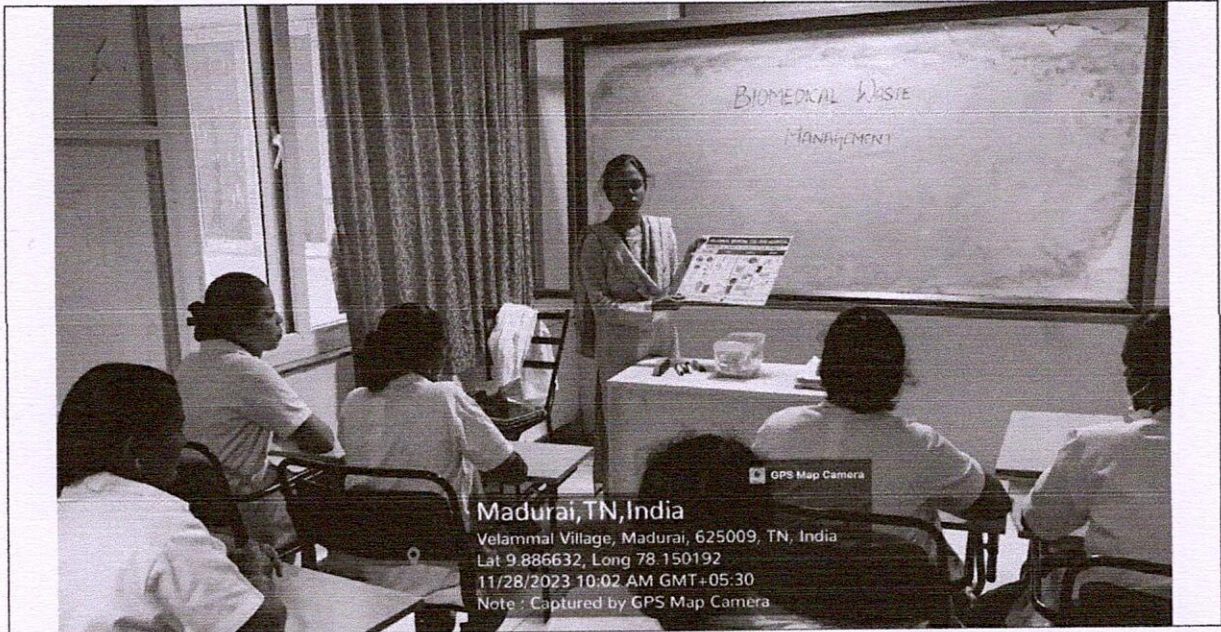



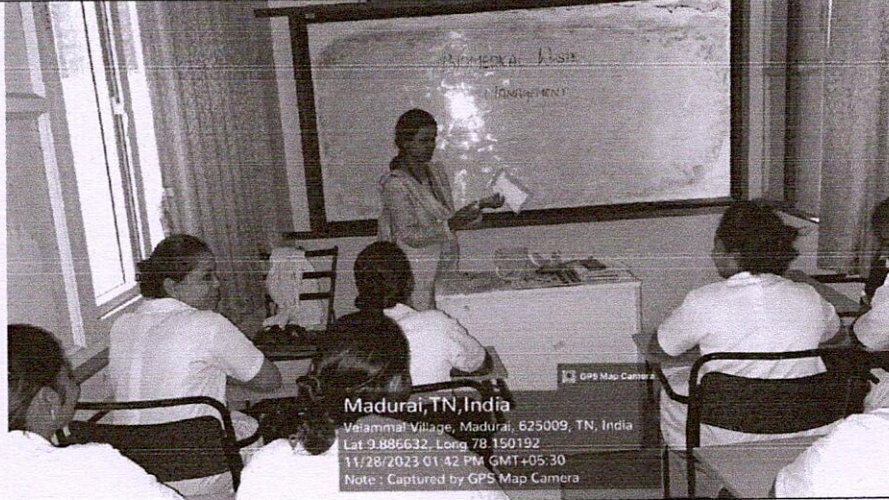

Spill management – Dr Vithiya

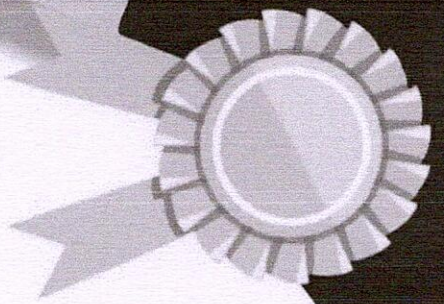

Workshop on Good Clinical Practice (GCP)

Date: 25th October 2023

Time: 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Venue: Medical College Lecture Hall, Velammal Medical College Hospital & Research Institute, Madurai

1. Welcome Address

The workshop began with a warm welcome by **Dr. PK Mohanty, MD**, Lab Director, VMCH&RI, Madurai. Dr. Mohanty emphasized the critical importance of Good Clinical Practice (GCP) in ensuring ethical and scientific standards in clinical research. He highlighted the workshop's relevance for postgraduate students in developing a strong foundation in clinical trial conduct, ethics, and regulatory compliance. He congratulated the Department of Pharmacology for organizing such an impactful session and encouraged participants to actively engage with the resource persons to gain practical insights into clinical research.

2. Programme Sessions – Detailed Summary

Session 1: GCP – An Overview (9:15 AM – 9:45 AM)

Speaker: Dr. Malathi, MD, DGO, Member Secretary-IEC, Associate Professor, Institute of Pharmacology, Madurai Medical College

- Dr. Malathi introduced the concept of GCP and its historical evolution, emphasizing milestones like the Nuremberg Code, Declaration of Helsinki, and ICH-GCP guidelines.
- She explained how GCP ensures participant safety, data integrity, and compliance with ethical principles in clinical trials.
- Key takeaways included the core principles of GCP and their application in clinical research.

Session 2: NDCT Rules 2019 – Overview & Salient Features (9:45 AM – 10:15 AM)

Speaker: Dr. Raj Kishore Mahato, MD, DNB, ACME, Member Secretary-IEC, Professor & Head, Dept. of Pharmacology, VMCH&RI

- Dr. Mahato detailed the New Drugs and Clinical Trials (NDCT) Rules 2019, focusing on its implications for ethics committees, investigators, and sponsors.
- Participants learned about streamlined processes for obtaining approvals, registration of ethics committees, and compensation mechanisms for trial-related injuries.
- The session provided practical guidance for complying with these regulations in India.

Session 3: Role of IEC in Research (10:30 AM – 11:00 AM)

Speaker: Dr. Navajyothi, MD, DNB (Derm), Professor & Head, Department of Dermatology, Govt. Theni Medical College

- Dr. Navajyothi explained the structure and functions of Institutional Ethics Committees (IECs) in research oversight.
- Topics included the ethical review process, expedited reviews, and reporting requirements.
- She also shared real-world examples of ethical dilemmas faced by IECs and how to address them.

Session 4: Role & Responsibilities of Principal Investigator/Sponsor (11:00 AM – 11:45 AM)

Speaker: Dr. KMS Susila, MD, DCH, Professor, Dept. of Pharmacology, VMCH&RI

- Dr. Susila elaborated on the responsibilities of investigators and sponsors in clinical trials, including protocol adherence, participant safety, and data management.
- Special emphasis was placed on the importance of maintaining accurate records and promptly reporting adverse events.

Session 5: Informed Consent Process (11:45 AM – 12:30 PM)

Speaker: Dr. Alphones Stanley Xavier, MD, DNB, DM (Clinical Pharmacology), Assistant Professor, Dept. of Pharmacology, AIIMS-Madurai

- Dr. Xavier provided a detailed overview of the informed consent process, including its ethical significance and legal implications.
- Role-play exercises helped participants understand practical challenges, such as ensuring comprehension among diverse populations.

Session 6: Reporting of Serious Adverse Events & Compensation Guidelines (12:30 PM – 1:00 PM)

Speaker: Dr. Muthu Meera R, MD, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Pharmacology, VMCH&RI

- Dr. Muthu Meera covered the process for identifying, documenting, and reporting serious adverse events (SAEs) during clinical trials.
- She also outlined the NDCT rules regarding compensation for trial-related injuries or deaths, providing case examples for clarity.



She reiterated the importance of applying the knowledge gained in clinical research practices and encouraged attendees to further their understanding of GCP.

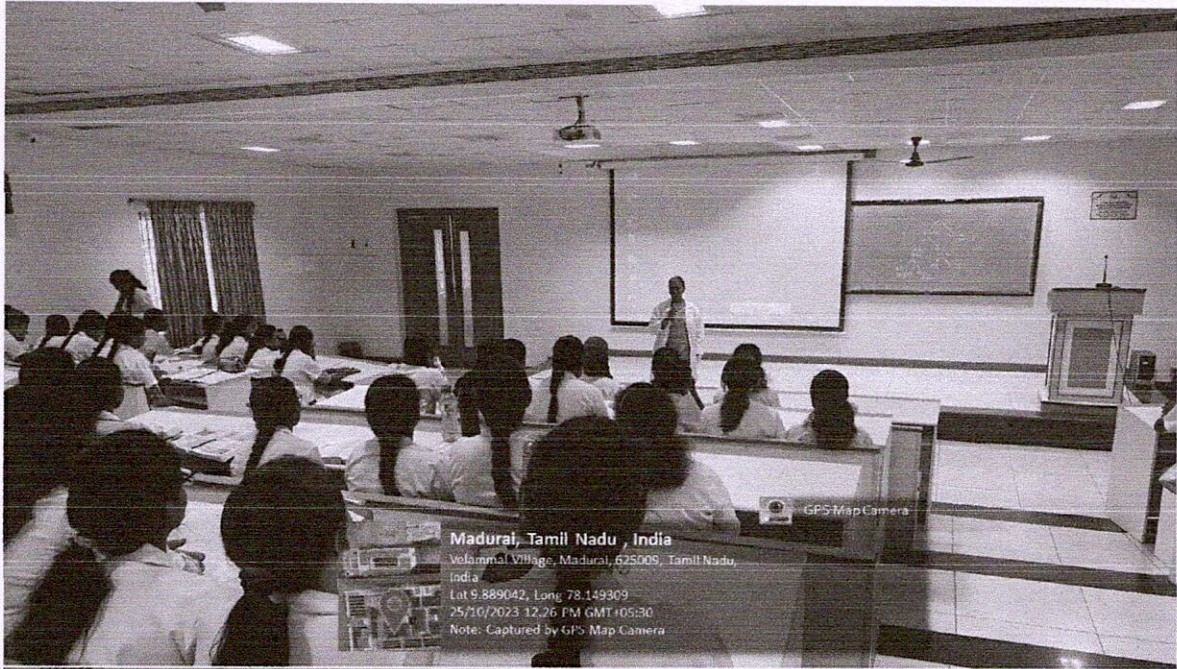

4. Key Outcomes and Feedback

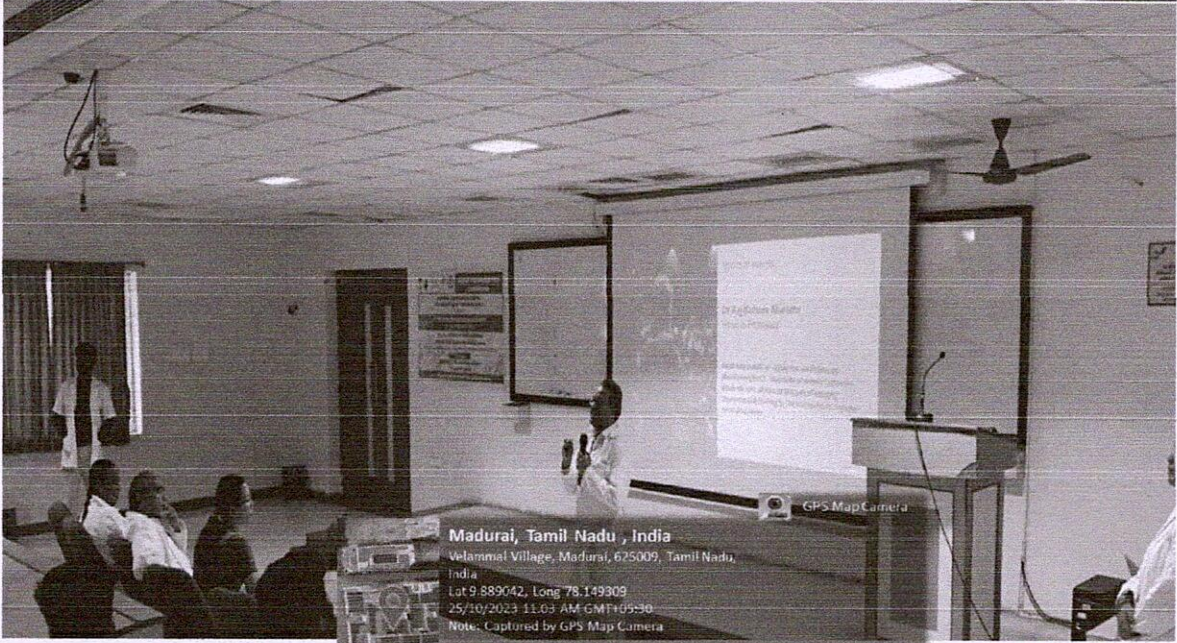
- 95% of participants rated the workshop as highly informative.

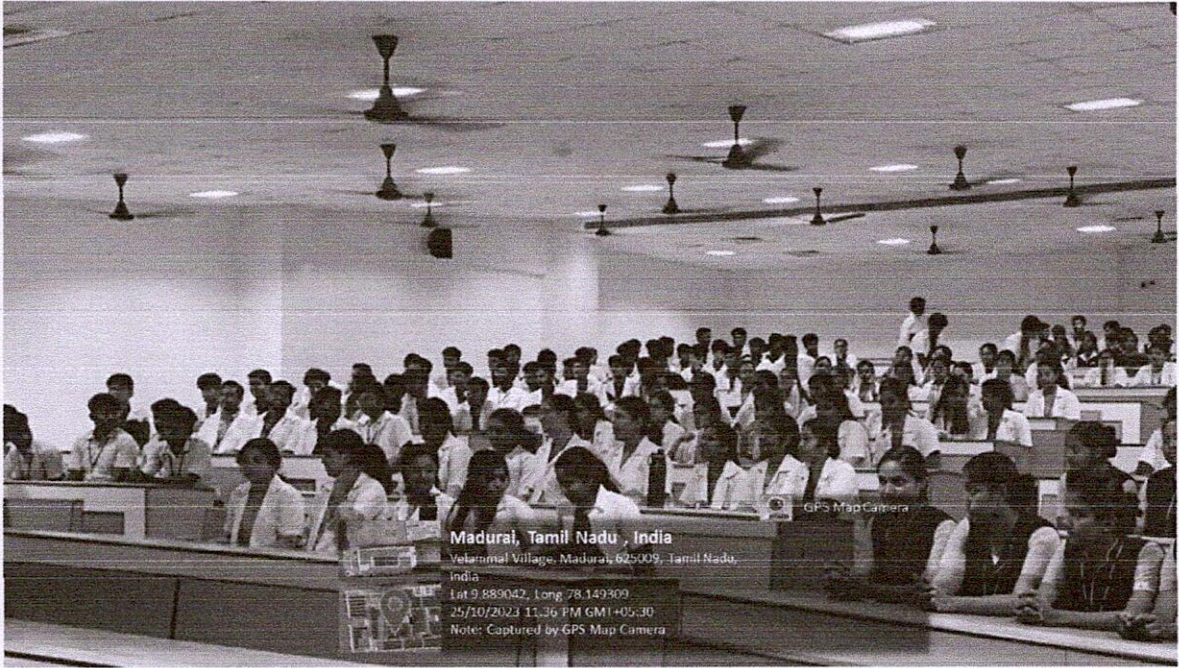


Session 2: NDCT Rules 2019 – Overview & Salient Features (9:45 AM – 10:15 AM)

Report of Intellectual Property Rights Programme.

The Department of Community Medicine at Velammal Medical College Hospital & Research Institute, Madurai, organized a seminar on Intellectual Property Rights on 30th November 2023 in Lecture Hall 4. The seminar aimed to create awareness about the importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and its various aspects.

The seminar commenced with an introduction and welcome address by Dr. BG Mahesh Krishna. Followed by the first session conducted by Dr. Ponmalar, on overview of IPR and the different types of IPRs. She explained the different methods of commercializing IPR, such as licensing, franchising, and selling. The seminar concluded with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Rajkishore, Professor and Head of the Department of Pharmacology, VMCH&RI. He thanked the speakers and participants for their valuable contributions and emphasized the importance of IPR in the healthcare sector.

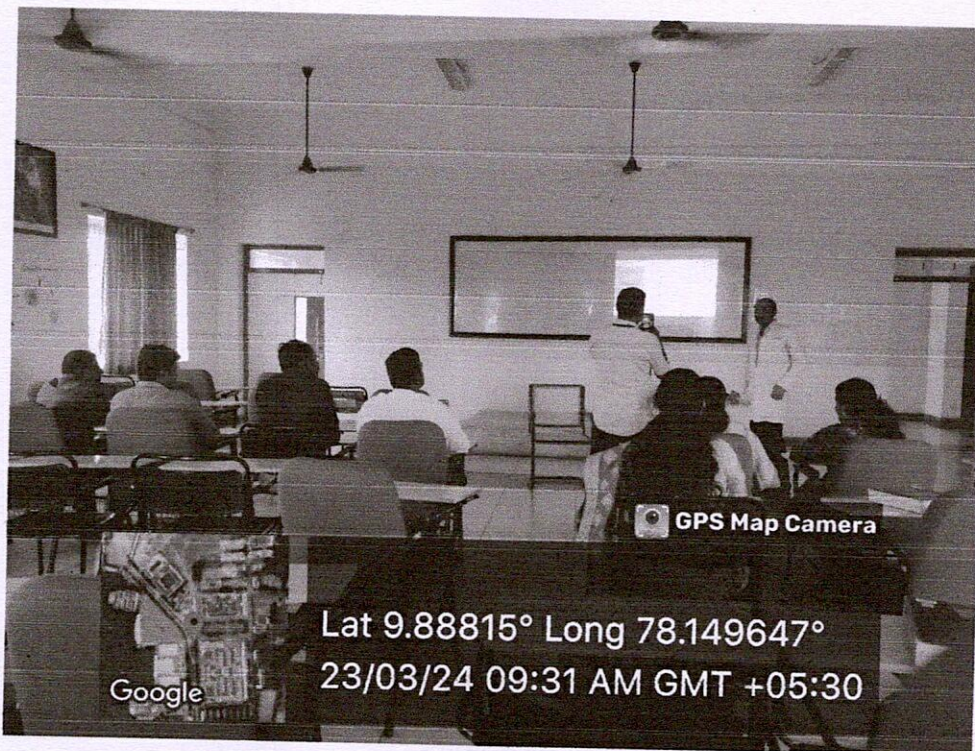
2:40 – 3:40 pm: Budgeting & Financial Planning

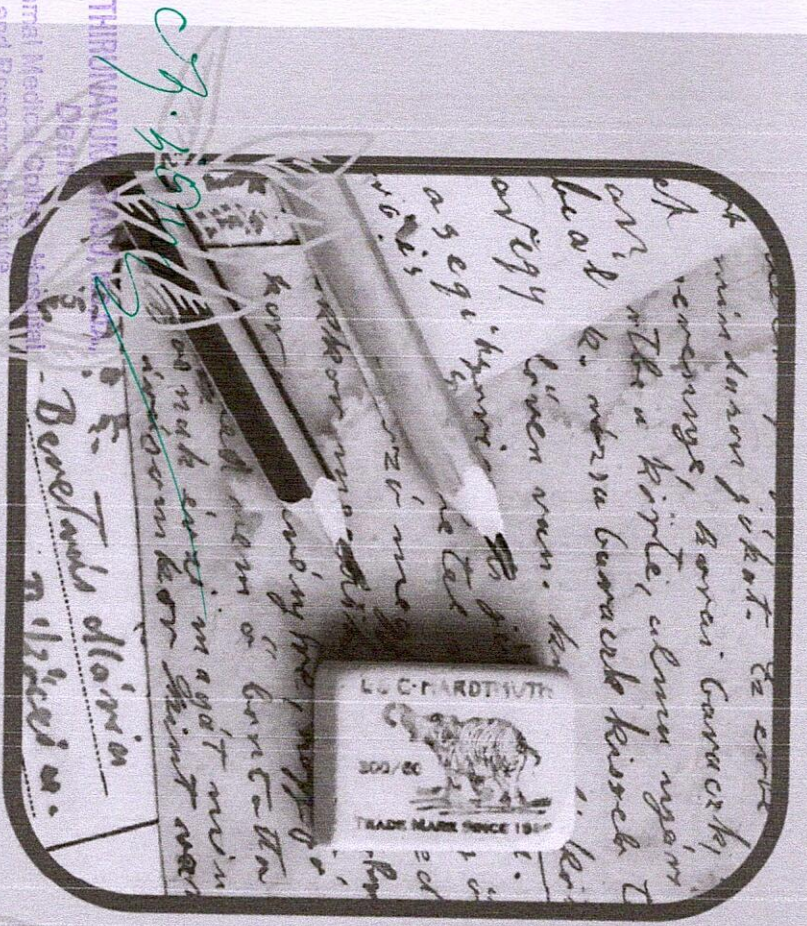



The workshop on effective medical writing and publishing organised by the department of Community Medicine was held on 21.10.2023. The aim of the workshop was to equip postgraduates with the skills and knowledge required to write and publish effective research papers in medical journals. The workshop was attended by 46 members of the teaching faculty.

The workshop was divided into three sessions. The first session focused on the fundamentals of medical writing, including the structure and format of a research paper. Dr Praveena, Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine, discussed the various sections of a research paper, including the abstract, introduction, methodology, results, and discussion. He also provided tips on how to write clear and concise sentences, avoid common grammar and punctuation errors, and use appropriate medical terminology.

The second session focused on the process of manuscript submission and publication. Dr Sriandaal discussed the various types of medical journals, the submission guidelines for each journal, and the peer review process. Dr Sudhir also provided tips on how to choose the right journal for a research paper, how to write an effective cover letter, and how to respond to reviewer comments. The final session focused on the ethical considerations of medical writing and publishing. Dr Suseela, Professor of Pharmacology, discussed the various ethical issues that can arise during the research and publication process, including plagiarism, data fabrication, and conflicts of interest. He also talked about how to avoid these ethical issues and how to ensure that research papers are conducted and reported ethically.

Throughout the workshop, the attendees were encouraged to participate in group discussions and ask questions. The resource persons also provided several exercises and writing prompts to help attendees practice their writing skills. Overall, the workshop was a great success and provided valuable insights and knowledge to medical professionals who are looking to write and publish research papers in medical journals.

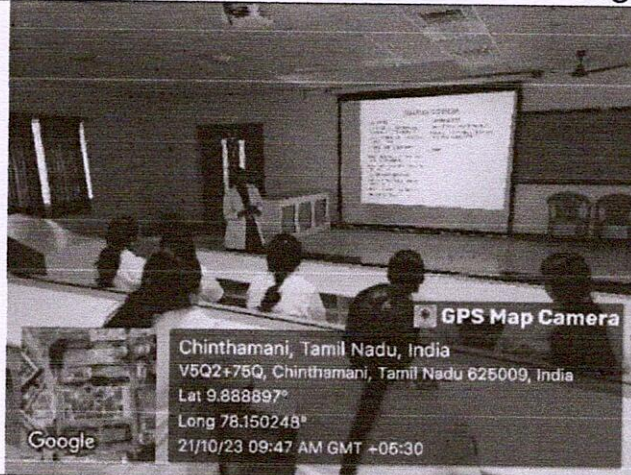




Dr. Sriandaal – Manuscript Submission and Publication
