Agenda:

1. Final review of extension activities conducted from June 2023 to February 2024
2. Identification of gaps in participation from non-Community Medicine departments
3. Suggestions for increasing activities and involvement of Velammal Engineering College

Key Discussions:

- Extension activity participation has not increased significantly. While Community Medicine, Medicine, Blood Bank, Ophthalmology, and Psychiatry have been consistently involved, other departments such as Surgery, Pediatrics, and Obstetrics & Gynecology have shown limited engagement in extension and ISR activities.
- A continued lack of adherence to the documentation format for activities was noted, particularly for obtaining necessary permissions.
- **Suggestions:**
 - S. Gopalakrishnan (NSS Coordinator) will assist in collaborating with Velammal Engineering College for joint extension programs, thus involving a larger group of students and departments.
 - It is important to increase coordination between departments to ensure all faculty and students are actively involved in extension and ISR activities.

Action Plan:

- Departments that are not actively involved in extension activities (other than Community Medicine, Medicine, Blood Bank, Ophthalmology, and Psychiatry) need to increase their participation to 2-3 activities per department per year.
- S. Gopalakrishnan will help initiate collaborations with Velammal Engineering College and encourage their students to participate in extension activities.
- Faculty must follow the prescribed formats for permission letters, transport arrangements, and event planning.

Outcome:

- All departments need to submit **proposals** for extension activities and strictly follow the **permission and documentation formats**.
- **NSS Coordinator (S. Gopalakrishnan)** will play a role in increasing **participation from Velammal Engineering College**.
- Increased **engagement** from non-Community Medicine departments is expected moving forward.


Key Discussions:

 - **Appreciation Letter** from the community or institution hosting the program.


Action Plan:

Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Velammal Medical College Extension Committee

1. Purpose The purpose of this SOP is to outline the procedures and responsibilities associated with the operations of the Extension Committee at Velammal Medical College, Madurai. The committee's primary role is to oversee the planning, execution, and monitoring of extension activities that support the college's mission of community service, outreach, and education.

2. Scope This SOP applies to all members of the Extension Committee, as well as faculty, staff, and students involved in extension activities or programs at Velammal Medical College.

3. Responsibilities The Extension Committee is responsible for:

- Organizing medical outreach and community welfare programs.
 - Coordinating medical camps, health education drives, and awareness programs.
 - Ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory standards for health services.
 - Managing resources, including funding and manpower, for extension programs.
 - Monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of extension activities.
 - Documenting and reporting extension outcomes to college leadership and stakeholders.

4. Committee Structure The Extension Committee should consist of:

- **Chairperson:** Senior faculty or a designated representative from the college management.
- **Secretary:** A faculty member responsible for meeting coordination and document management.
- **Members:** Representatives from various departments (e.g., Medical, Nursing, Allied Health), as well as student representatives and community partners.

5. Procedures

5.1 Planning and Approval of Extension Activities

- **Proposal Submission:** Any proposed extension activity should be submitted to the Extension Committee with a detailed plan, including objectives, timeline, resources required, and expected outcomes.
- **Review & Discussion:** The committee will review the proposal, discuss its alignment with the college's mission and community needs, and assess the feasibility.
- **Approval:** Upon approval by the committee, the proposal will be forwarded to the college leadership for final authorization.


5.2 Coordination with Stakeholders

- **Internal Coordination:** The Extension Committee will coordinate with various departments of the college (e.g., Community Medicine, Public Health) to ensure support for the extension activity.
- **External Coordination:** The committee will liaise with local authorities, NGOs, healthcare organizations, and community leaders to facilitate the activities.
- **Student Involvement:** Students from relevant programs (e.g., MBBS, Nursing, Allied Health Sciences) will be encouraged to participate, subject to academic schedules and guidelines.

5.3 Resource Management

- **Funding:** The committee will identify funding sources, including internal funds, donations, and grants, for extension activities. A budget should be prepared for each program.
- **Logistics:** The committee will oversee the procurement of materials and equipment necessary for the programs (e.g., medical supplies, transportation, etc.).
- **Human Resources:** Faculty and students may be allocated to different tasks, with clear roles and responsibilities defined.

- **Scheduling:** The committee will schedule activities in advance, ensuring that they do not conflict with academic calendars and other institutional commitments.
- **Execution:** On the day of the event or activity, the committee ensures that all logistical requirements are met, participants are informed, and all medical and safety protocols are followed.
- **Documentation:** Records of all activities, including attendance, expenses, outcomes, and feedback, will be maintained.

5.5 Monitoring & Evaluation


- **Tracking Progress:** The committee will monitor the progress of ongoing extension activities and resolve any issues that arise.
- **Post-Activity Review:** After the activity, the committee will evaluate its success based on predefined objectives (e.g., number of people reached, health impact, feedback from participants).
- **Reporting:** A report summarizing the activity, outcomes, and recommendations for future programs will be prepared and submitted to the college administration.

5.6 Compliance & Reporting

- **Regulatory Compliance:** The committee will ensure that all activities comply with government health regulations, ethical guidelines, and medical standards.
- **Periodic Reporting:** The Extension Committee will provide regular reports to the college administration, including budgets, progress, and outcomes of extension activities.

6. Documentation and Record Keeping All documents related to extension activities, including proposals, budgets, approval forms, meeting minutes, reports, and evaluations, should be archived for future reference. These records must be kept for a minimum of **5 years**.


7. Review and Revision This SOP should be reviewed annually by the Extension Committee and revised as necessary to ensure that it reflects current practices, regulatory requirements, and the evolving needs of the college and the community.


The NSS unit of Velammal Medical College in collaboration with Mahelercen, Madurai, conducted a Leprosy Screening campaign in Mayapuram, Vadipatti, Madurai on 29.04.2024 which was conducted by Dr. Sriandaal and Dr. Bharath Rajh.


15 student's 2nd year MBBS students have participated in the campaign. Prior to the visit, basic instructions were given to the students regarding the history and clinical signs of leprosy. They were instructed to go door to door survey cum clinical examination of all the household members.

At the location, students were split into two groups and was taken into the community for door-to-door leprosy screening by Dr. Bharath.

In this screening campaign, students identified one adult male with a hypopigmented, anaesthetic patch in his left forearm. Patient details was obtained and has been referred to the nearby health centre for further investigation and management.

Then people in that locality were gathered around, to whom the students gave health education about the need for this leprosy screening campaign and emphasized that early detection in leprosy cases can be cured completely without any complication.

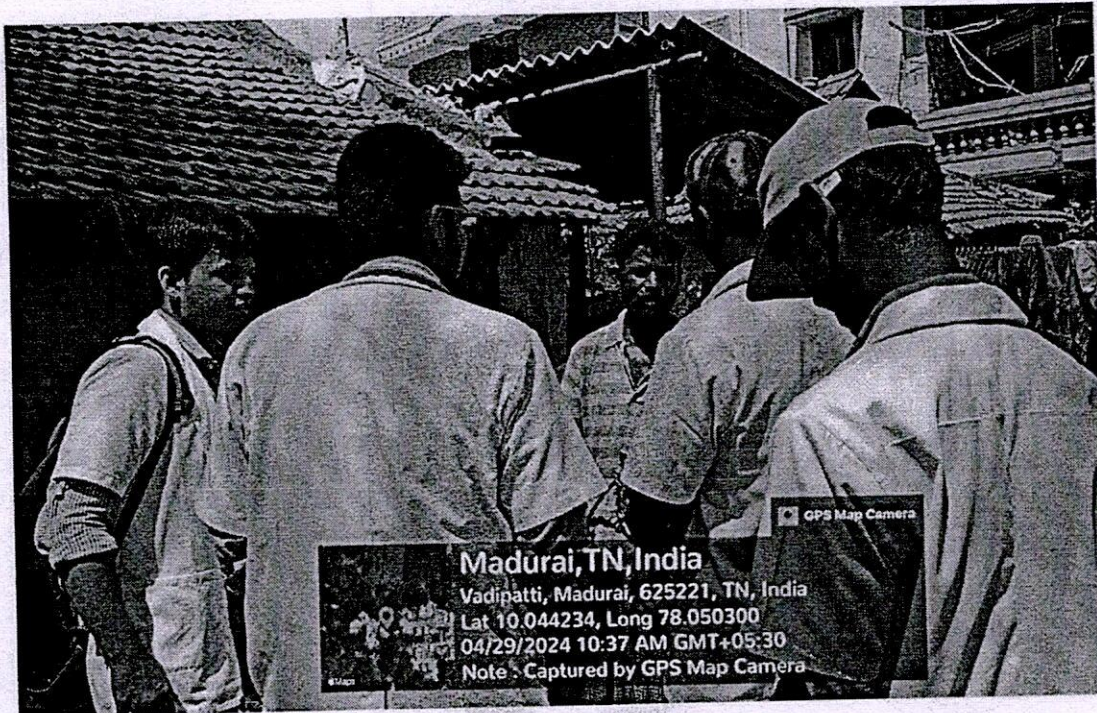

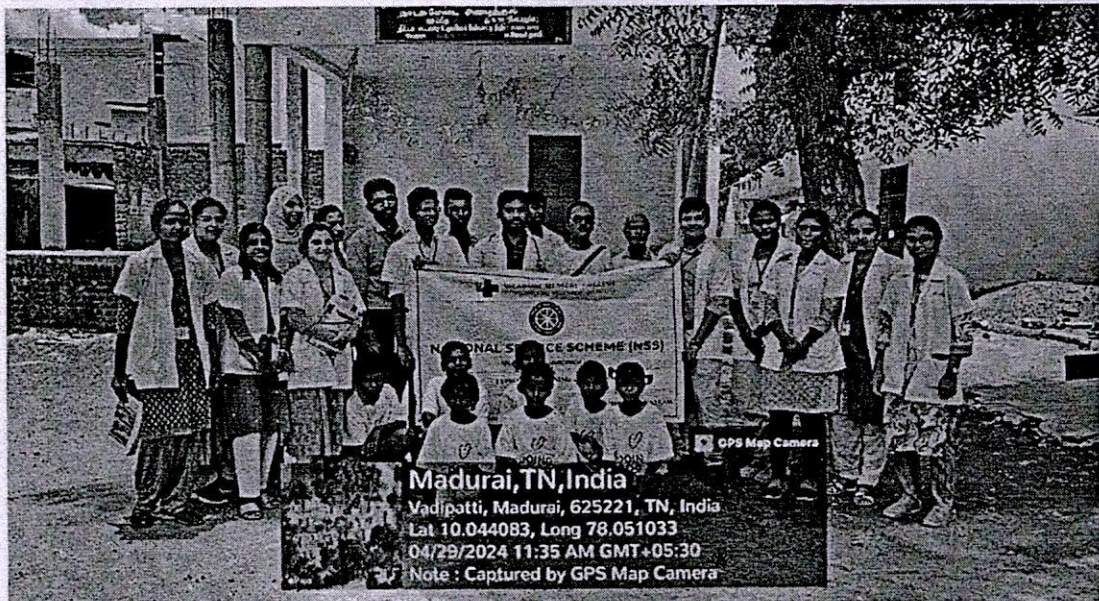



The NSS unit of Velammal Medical College in collaboration with Mahelercen, Madurai, conducted a Leprosy Screening campaign in Mayapuram, Vadipatti, Madurai on 29.04.2024 which was conducted by Dr. Sriandaal and Dr. Bharath Rajh. 15 student's 2nd year MBBS students have participated in the campaign. Prior to the visit, basic instructions were given to the students regarding the history and clinical signs of leprosy. They were instructed to go door to door survey and clinical examination of all the household members.

At the location, students were split into two groups and were taken into the community for door-to-door leprosy screening by Dr. Bharath. In this screening campaign, students identified one adult male with a hypopigmented, anaesthetic patch in his left forearm. Patient details were obtained and have been referred to the nearby health centre for further investigation and management. Then people in that locality were gathered around, to whom the students gave health education about leprosy signs and symptoms, self-identification techniques and the need for this leprosy screening campaign and emphasized that early detection in leprosy cases can be cured completely without any complication.
