



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Program report

Day 1:

The workshop on research for evidence-based practice was started with a pre-test which was carried out by Dr. Sriandaal, Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine which was followed by an ice breaking activity for the participants so as they introduce one another.

Inauguration was done by the honourable dignitaries of Velammal Medical College Hospital and Research Institute. Lamp lighting was done by Mr. Manivannan – CAO sir, Dr. Thirunavukkarasu – Dean sir, Dr. Ganesh prabhu – MS sir, Dr. Mahesh Krishna – Vice principal and Dr. Mohanty – Lab director.


First session of the day was on understanding evidence-based practice, which was handled by Dr. Senthil Murugan, Assistant professor, Department of Cardiology. He emphasized about the different types of evidences and its importance in clinical medicine with appropriate clinical scenarios.

Next session was managed by Dr. Sudhir Ben, associate professor, department of community medicine. His talk was on how to generate an evidence and how to apply such evidences in the clinical scenario with appropriate examples.

Post tea break session was handled by Dr. Karthik Raj, Associate Professor, Department of paediatrics. He explained about the basic summary about the types of research design and went into his topic – Case reports and case series. Starting from history to ending with the advantages and disadvantages of the case studies, he explained in depth and in an easily understandable way.

Dr. Sriandaal, Assistant professor, Department of community medicine started the session on Descriptive studies. Explained the different types of descriptive studies with av aids and made the session much more interactive for the participants.

Pre-lunch session was handled by Dr.Samir Bele, Professor & Head, Department of Community Medicine. Session was split into two – Analytical studies and Randomized control trails. He explained about the types of analytical studies such as Case control studies and cohort studies. Emphasised the importance of analytical studies in finding the association between two study groups and in testing a hypothesis. In RCT, He explained about the basics about RCT,


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Post tea break session was on how to design a questionnaire, which was handled by Dr. Priya, Head of Department & Director In-charge, Department of Community Medicine, Madurai Medical College. Different types of questionnaire was dealt in detail with various examples and different types of questions that can be used in questionnaire was also explained. She added points on the advantages of certain questions type with help of case scenario.

Next session was dealt by Dr. Sriandaal, Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine. Topic for this quick session was on data collection with the help of google forms – how to create a google form, how to articulate different types of question and how it is much easier to use google form than standard method was explained precisely. Google sheet usage for data entry is made easy with the introduction of google forms. Method to enter data in Ms Xcel spread sheet was explained briefly.


Pre lunch session was on Review of journal article, which was handled by Dr. Subramanian, Consultant Rheumatologist, Velammal Medical College Hospital & Research Institute. He explained the need for article appraisal. He then explained the various standard checklists used for critical appraisal based on the study design. The session was very interactive and productive.

Post lunch session was a group activity session on sample size calculation, moderated by Mr. Vijay Anto, Statistician, Department of Community Medicine. He continued next session which was on Application of statistical software for data analysis. In this session he explained about the various tests available for data analysis and also emphasized on using which test for different types of variables with examples.

Day concluded with a group activity conducted by Dr. Sriandaal, Assistant Professor and Mr. Vijay Anto, Statistician, Department of Community Medicine. This activity was on how to create a google form and to create different types of questionnaire. Each group of participants created one form each and presented it. And this interactive session cleared the major doubts about how to use the google form and sheets.

Day 3:

Day 3 started with recap of day 2 by participants, moderated by Dr. Praveena, Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine.


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First session was on Introduction to variables which was done by Dr. Sudhir Ben, Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine. He explained briefly about the different types of variables.

Following session was on Presentation of data, by Dr. Vasumathi, Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine. She dealt with different types of tables and different charts that can be used in presentation of data. With appropriate pictures and examples, it was made easy to understand.

Next session was on How to write a research report, dealt by Dr. Trupti Bodhare, Professor & Head, Department of Community medicine, AIIMS, Madurai. She explained the steps in writing the research article or manuscript. Methods to write the research in a simple manner.

Post tea break session was handled by Dr. Pookamalam, Associate Professor, Department of ENT. She explained basic information about plagiarism. And the need to check plagiarism before submission as it may be rejected if the write up was copied from a different article. Then she explained briefly about the authorship details also.

Next session was on Dissertation Guideline by Dr. Raj Kishore, Professor and Head, Department of Pharmacology. He explained in detail about the steps involved in doing a dissertation project. Emphasized on the important aspects of the guidelines. He continued the next session on introduction to Ethics and explained in brief about the importance of ethical aspects in medical research.



Celiac Disease, also known as Celiac Sprue or Gluten-Sensitive Enteropathy, is a chronic condition characterized by an adverse reaction to gluten, a protein found in wheat, barley, and rye. The guest speaker discussed the cornerstone of Celiac Disease management, which is strict adherence to a gluten-free diet. Attendees learned about the challenges of maintaining a gluten-free lifestyle and the importance of proper nutrition and dietary education.

The lecture also touched upon potential complications and long-term effects of untreated Celiac Disease, including malabsorption, osteoporosis, infertility, and an increased risk of certain malignancies.

Following the Registration and Inauguration, the first session covered Quality Assurance Overview. Dr. Sudhir began the discussion by explaining what he meant by the most dynamic and subjective concept, quality. He then discussed quality assurance, both internal and external, and the reasons why it's necessary overall. Next, the significance of quality assurance in medical education was emphasised. He defined quality assurance in this context as pertaining to faculty development, curriculum and assessment quality, teaching staff quality, input procedures, and human resource management.

The topic of Dr. Samir Bele's subsequent seminar was IQAC accreditation. He discussed the Quality Initiative, Quality Sustenance, and Quality Enhancement as the main foci of evaluation and accreditation. He next discussed the steps involved in accreditation, including as preparing an SSR, submitting a letter of intent, and conducting peer reviews. He closed the discussion by outlining the advantages of accreditation, which include helping the institution identify its potential, strengths, and limitations as well as promoting intra- and inter-institutional contacts and cutting-edge, modern teaching techniques.

Creating Curriculum Dr. Praveena's session primarily covered the assessment indications. She discussed how to take the institutional aims into account. It also made reference to the importance of establishing global competences in the curriculum and how it relates to local, regional, national, and global development concerns. She ended the meeting by saying Strategies for curriculum enrichment

Dr. John Rajpathy discussed faculty training and evaluation, two crucial elements of quality assurance. He discussed how IQAC guarantees faculty members' ongoing growth and development. According to what he said, faculty training determines the training needs of faculty members in light of their academic specialisations, pedagogy, current trends, and institutional objectives. Conversely, in the faculty evaluation, he discussed the various techniques of assessment, including administrative, peer, self, and student evaluations. He talked about the aspect of continuous professional development in his conclusion.

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Student Training and Evaluation was the following topic, just as vital as the prior one. Dr. Sudharsan discussed the demands of students in terms of training and how to create programmes that meet those needs. He stated that topics including critical thinking, problem solving, teamwork, leadership, career counselling, and entrepreneurship should be covered in these sessions. He went on to discuss the importance of student evaluations, saying that they have to be a thorough process that evaluates students' abilities, academic achievements, and general development. Additionally, he enumerated the many types of evaluation, such as research papers, project work, exams, presentations, exams, and practical evaluations. He spoke briefly about mentoring, counselling, grievance redressal, and feedback before calling the meeting to a close.

Dr. Samir Bele discussed the Internal Quality Assurance Cell's (IQAC) critical function of fostering collaboration. He explained that the cooperation is between the different internal and external partners of the organisation. He discussed the advantages of the same, emphasising in particular how it advances institutional growth and overall quality improvement. The seminar also covered the ways in which IQAC may promote collaboration, including with academic institutions, external partners, students, and regulatory and accreditation agencies. In his closing remarks, he emphasised the need of teamwork for institutional development, innovation promotion, and ongoing improvement.

In the final session, "Promotion of Ethical and Professional Conduct," Dr. Rajkishore Mahato defined Professional Conduct as the faculty, staff, and students inside the school acting ethically, with integrity, and adhering to rules and regulations. Then, she discussed how IQAC addresses professional conduct, which includes creating codes of ethics and conduct, distributing and implementing regulations, running programmes for training and awareness, keeping an eye on and assessing professional conduct, and encouraging professional development. After briefing each of them, the meeting came to an end. IQAC is essential to upholding integrity, ethical standards, and a positive learning environment since it addresses professional conduct.


Dr. Samir Bele gave a welcome speech and introduction before the programme got underway.

Speaking about the context and changes in medical education, Dr. Samir Bele emphasised some of the educational obstacles to these changes. She gave a thorough explanation of quality and quality assurance procedures. Dr Samir explained in details the coordination of Quality Assurance Process, importance of understanding of the various standards being used and adequate preparation and planning. He emphasised that an effective communication strategy. And everyone including Staff, students, trainees, and other stakeholders need to understand the rationale and significance of the quality assurance process including what is to take place and their contribution. He talked about accrediting teams should work cooperatively meeting agreed deadlines for written submissions.

Dr. Sudhir Ben emphasised that a range of instructional modalities should be used to deliver the training, which utilises the cognitive, psychomotor, and affective domains of learning. There should be ample opportunity for both vertical and horizontal curriculum integration. There should be a clear connection between the program's instruction and research. The appropriateness of clinical interaction in a variety of healthcare settings is one important issue to address.

According to Dr. John Rajpathy, Professor, Department of Physiology, every medical college is hosting FDPs in compliance with the specific recommendation provided by the regulatory agency. He underlined the need to ensure the quality assurance of these programmes and the need for a follow-up evaluation of the outcomes. He advised accessing the FDP's quality assurance through the internal or external methods for quality assurance.

Dr. Rajkishore Mahato talked on the several types of feedback, their purposes, their components, and feedback and evaluation.


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In addition to addressing the validity and reliability of the assessment tools for each specific skill, Dr. Rajkishore Mahato emphasised the importance of standardised assessment in medical education. He suggested holding a workshop to train faculty members in the process of evaluation. Dr. S Nataraja Rathinam contends that assessment in any setting pertaining to medical education need to be based on the learning outcomes of the course and in line with its objectives. It must be a top priority to give great formative assessment through regular feedback. Assessment processes should include direct observation of core clinical competence, behaviours, and professional practice domains. A feasible assessment plan need to include a workload that instructors and students can realistically finish.

Dr. Sumana R discussed fostering a culture of excellence. She underlined the importance of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as one of the essential support structures that teachers at medical colleges depend on to ensure the standard of their instruction. By using IQAC, they may demonstrate that they are in control of the quality of their education, that they consistently update and improve their curricula, and that they meet or exceed the requirements of accrediting authorities.

At last, Dr. Samir Bele spoke about governance and evaluation. In his opinion, the medical education programme should clearly outline the committee structures that supervise the program's operations and ensure that trainees or students have appropriate representation on these committees. In accordance with the program's educational missions and objectives, the governance should ensure autonomy and control over decision-making, including the program's overall strategic direction and budgetary allocation. It's critical to define precisely what the academic leadership of the programme is responsible for. Programme assessments need to be transparent and truthful, considering the goals of the programme as well as the background and content of the curriculum. Accreditation teams will be particularly interested in a program's capacity to incorporate user feedback into future design and development.

Criterion – III: Research, Innovations, and Extension


- Participants were informed about the importance of research, innovation, and extension activities in enhancing institutional quality. Various metrics and benchmarks for this criterion were discussed.

Criterion – VIII: Institutional Innovation and Entrepreneurship


- The session emphasized the role of innovation and entrepreneurship in driving institutional growth and development. Examples of successful entrepreneurial initiatives were discussed.

The workshop successfully achieved its objectives of sensitizing participants to the NAAC AQAR guidelines and equipping them with the knowledge and tools necessary for effective implementation.

Recommendations

1. **Regular Training Programs:** It is recommended to conduct regular training programs for IQAC members and faculty to keep them updated with the latest NAAC guidelines and best practices.
2. **Collaboration and Networking:** Encouraging collaboration and networking among institutions to share experiences and strategies for quality enhancement.
3. **Continuous Improvement:** Institutions should focus on continuous improvement by regularly reviewing and updating their quality assurance processes in line with NAAC standar


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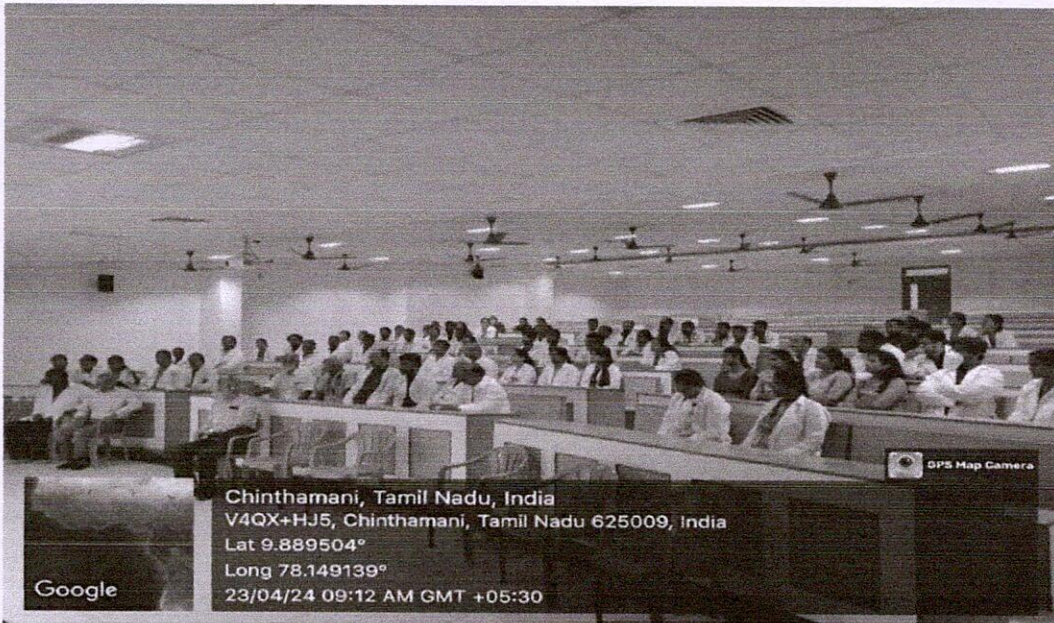
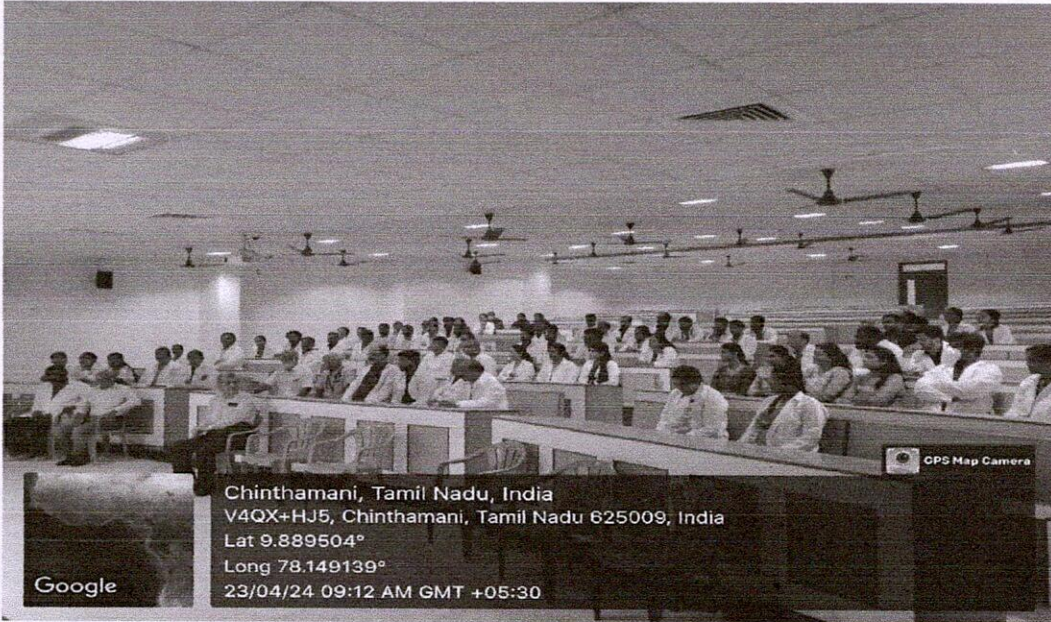
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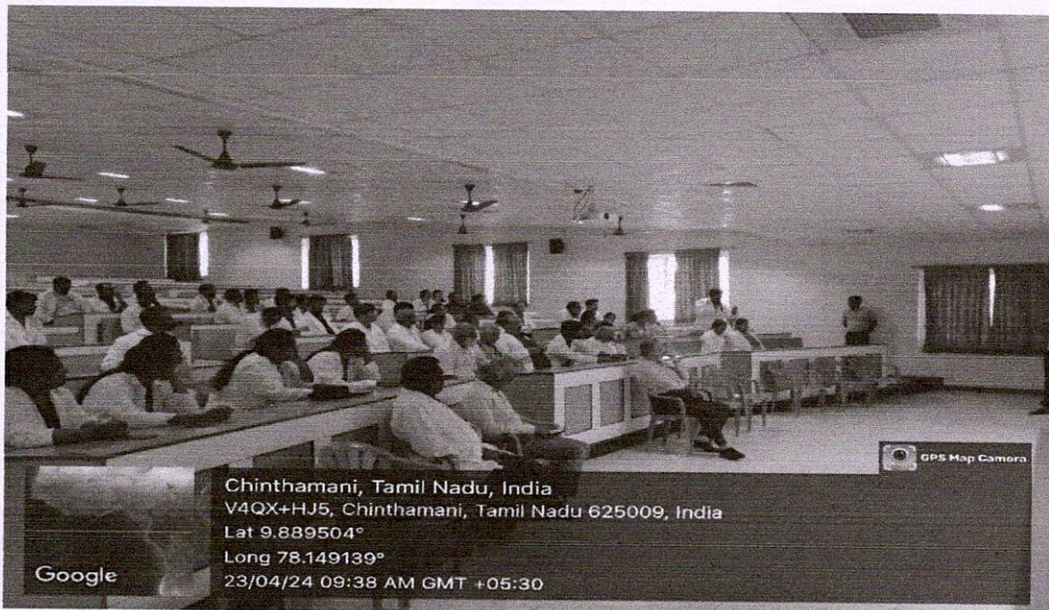
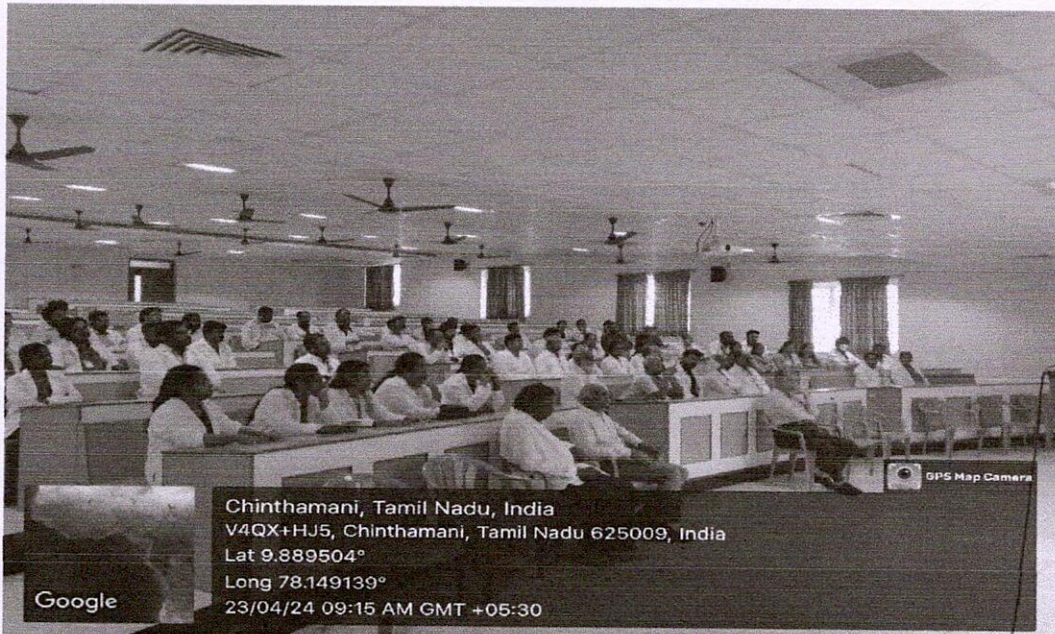
