2. Ensures curriculum alignment with GMER recommendations

- The curriculum committee (CC) ensures that the institutional curricular plan and its delivery are aligned to and in accordance to the principles and requirements enshrined in the GMR document.

3. Ensures continuous update of curriculum

- The Curriculum Committee works to continually update the medical curriculum and to ensure that students receive the most effective and relevant curriculum for the practice of medicine.

FUNCTIONS OF THE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

1. Curriculum Design and Management Functions:

- Review Competencies – Review, evaluate, and periodically update the competencies of the entire medical education program.

2. Ensure adequate coverage of all competencies throughout the curriculum.

- Consult with individual course directors to evaluate whether the distribution of competencies among courses is logical and coherent.

3. Ensure Vertical and Horizontal Integration

• **Horizontal Integration**

- Assess whether each course employs multidisciplinary, foundational concepts from the pertinent basic sciences disciplines that advance understanding of clinical medicine.

• **Vertical Integration**

- Assess whether the sequencing of courses provides a functional building of concepts to facilitate student learning.

The role of the curriculum committee in this process as follows


1. Overall, in-charge of the curricular delivery and monitor the smooth conduct of the program
2. Meets at least 4 times a year (quarterly)
3. Develop a strategy for creating and implementing the curriculum and providing oversight
4. Create a phase-wise Curriculum Subcommittee (PWCSC) to oversee the creation and delivery of aligned and integrated curriculum.
5. Creates the **timetable** with the help of the curriculum sub-committees (CSC) and alignment and integration team (AIT) and approves them
6. Decide if the alignment will be topic or organ system based,
7. Create and support topic teams which will develop objectives and learning sessions for each topic across the phases,
8. Approve and release the **annual timetable** for each phase,
9. Liaise with the Medical Education Unit or Department for required faculty support.
10. Provides necessary authority and support for the work of the curriculum
11. To schedule the usage of **skill labs** by students of each phase and interns (MCI 2019 CISP - doc)
12. To coordinate with the administration and clinical faculty
13. To monitor and submit reports to the Dean


- Evaluation:





- It should provide on the job training or formal courses for teachers.


Aim: To bring a qualitative and quantitative change in the teaching-learning process for both undergraduate and post graduate students of the college.

After a short tea break, Dr. Praise, Assistant Professor of Medicine, led a session on addressing ethical dilemmas in virtual care. She discussed the importance of informed consent and maintaining professional boundaries in telemedicine, ensuring that patient care remains ethical and effective even in a virtual setting.

Dr. N. Subramanian, Consultant Rheumatologist, concluded the instructional sessions with strategies for incorporating telemedicine training into medical curricula. He highlighted the need to prepare future healthcare professionals for telehealth practice, ensuring they are proficient in using telemedicine technologies and understanding their implications for patient care.


